Base Ministries & DTS Preparation

Our full schedule of English Club and orphanage visits continues and we have seen the Lord use us mightily. During the week that Daniel taught for the Kyiv DTS we did street evangelism several times and had some awesome ministry to the homeless. We partner with a church here that has rehab centers and a coffeehouse where those with addictions can get connected for help.

We will start a two week Discipleship Training School staff training on the Monday after

Thanksgiving. This is an exciting and great opportunity to train our amazing team for the coming (and future) schools here in Vinnitsa. Our diverse team of staff are from 5 different nations: Australia, Canada, Ukraine, Great Britain and U.S.A. We have quality staff and each bring unique gifts to this school.
